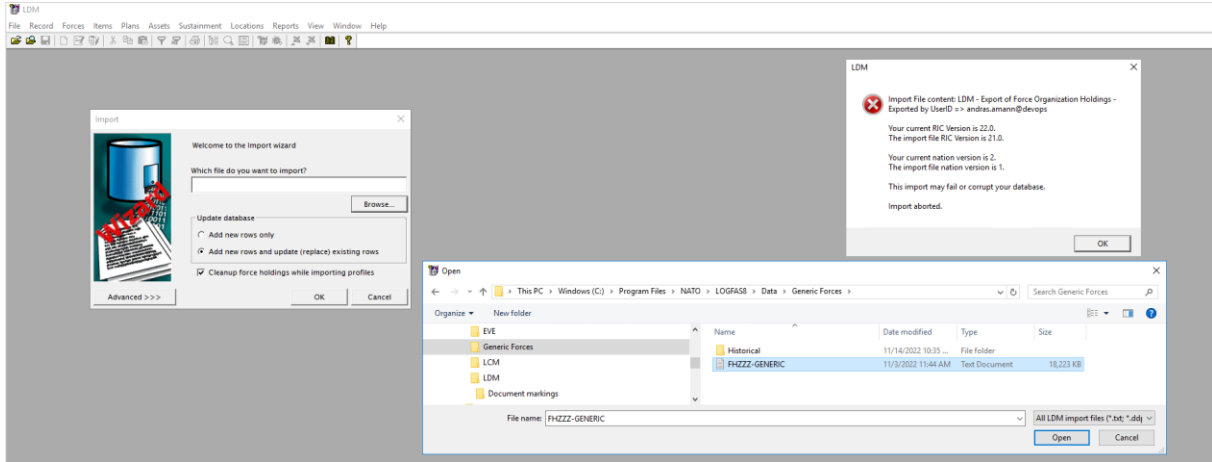
Importing the FHZZZ-GENERIC Error

1. GENERAL

The FHZZZ-GENERIC.txt file that is deployed as part of the LOGFAS 8.0.0 installation does not match the baseline logbase database reference data.

2. SYMPTOMS

Then importing the FHZZZ-GENERIC.txt from the C:\Program Files\NATO\LOGFAS8\Data\Generic Forces folder into a new database created in LOGFAS 8.0.0 an error will occur.



3. CAUSE

The baseline for a new database in LOGFAS 8.0.0 is:

Logbase Version	Asset	Geo	RIC	SQL	Nation	CC	HNS
Logbase 800	7	14	22	25000	2	2	0

The FHZZZ-GENERIC.txt file is RIC 21, Nation 1, unless the database has the same reference configuration the import will be aborted in LDM.

4. RESOLUTION / WORKAROUND

Import the Logbase700.backup database from the C:\Program Files\NATO\LOGFAS8\Data\LCM folder. This database is in the same configuration as the FHZZZ-GENERIC.txt file.

Logbase700.backup	7	14	21	24000	1	2	0

Once the Database has been imported, activate this database, and import the FHZZZ-GENERIC.txt file.

Update the reference data using the RIC and Nation using the Update_RIC_V21_V22_NATO_UNCLASSIFIED_05JAN21.txt and Nation_v2.xml files from the C:\Program Files\NATO\LOGFAS8\Common\GEOLOC_RIC_ASSETTYPE folder.

The Force Profile and Holdings can now be exported as a .txt file in the current baseline version and imported into any new database created in LOGFAS 8.0.0.
