The Centre is a multinational entity with Italy, Albania and Slovenia as Sponsoring Nations. The project started in 2016 following the proposal from the Italian Minister of Defence for the creation of a NATO SFA COE with the aim to promote Stability and Reconstruction efforts for any crisis scenario and to become a SFA focal point for the Alliance. The Centre was formally created on the 13th of December 2017 with the MOU signature between the Sponsoring Nations and Allied Command Transformation

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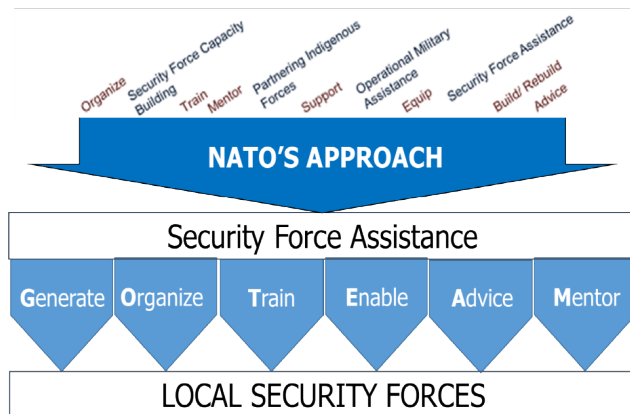
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## NATO STRATEGIC CONCEPT
