

MEMORANDUM





3. Affiant further says that the mother, Sarah Ann Nolan, has demonstrated violence in the past and this affiant is concerned for the welfare of his son.



This cause came on for consideration for an order for HLA Blood Group tests. The court finds the following:

That defendant, Thomas Michael Lane, Jr., and plaintiff, Sarah Ann Nolan shall submit to HLA Blood Group testing pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 3111.09.

It is further ORDERED that the defendant herein, Thomas Michael Lane, Jr. shall appear at Geauga Hospital, 13207 Ravenna Rd., Chardon, Ohio, 44024 on Monday, August 14, 1995 at 1:30 p.m. and submit blood samples for purposes of the HLA Blood Group testing and bring a picture identification such as a driver's license.

It is further ORDERED that Sarah Ann Nolan and child, Thomas Michael Lane, III, shall appear at the Geauga Hospital, 13207 Ravenna Rd., Ohio, 44024 on Monday, August 14, 1995 at 10:00 a.m.

and submit blood samples for purposes of the HLA Blood Group testing and bring a picture identification, such as a driver's license and birth certificate for the minor child.

It is further ORDERED that the cost of said testing shall be paid by the Geauga County Department of Human Services pursuant to the contract price of \$70.00 per individual.

It is further ORDERED that a notarized copy of said HLA Blood Group tests shall be forwarded to Jonathon P. Evans, Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, 231 Main Street, Courthouse Annex, Chardon, Ohio, 44024.

It is further ORDERED that the cost of said HLA Blood Group testing will be reimbursed by the defendant upon further order of the court should said defendant be found to be the father.


It is further ORDERED that should the results of said HLA Blood Group testing exclude the defendant as the father of said minor child, then the within matter shall be dismissed without prejudice against said defendant, at no cost to the defendant.

It is further ORDERED that should the defendant not be excluded then the within matter shall be continued and reset for pretrial.


