It has come to my attention that Adriana Gatti, of Argentina, may have suffered grave violation of her human rights at the hand of the country of Argentina. Information forwarded to me indicates that she disappeared on April 9th, 1977 in Buenos Aires and is believed to have been kidnapped by the government.

With this background, I am sufficiently concerned that I would ask you to forward any relevant facts concerning the case that the Department or its Embassy might have; and information on any action the Department has taken or plans to take in the case.
