Their rights to due process of law under the Argentine Constitution have been violated. They have not been successfully linked to any crimes or unpatriotic activities. They have often been brutally mistreated by police officials. The Inter-American Commission on Human Rights reported in 1980 that such violations of the legal rights and human dignity of citizens and legal residents are all too frequent in Argentina.

I urge you to use your power to inquire into the fate of these inexplicably disappeared/detained persons and to help effect their release.
