Those persons mentioned by Mr. Henschel and Ms. Moldavsky namely: Dr. Adolfo Ruben Moldavsky, Jorge Luis Molina, Claudio Norberto Braverman, Miguel Sergio Arcuschin, Noemi Josefina Jansenson de Arcuschin, Carlos Boitano, Jorge Luis Badillo, Juan Carlos, Jorge Arturo and Daniel Alberto Daroqui, Francisco Bartucci, Hugo Jose Agosti, Carlos Enrique Hodl, Federico Eduardo Alvarez Rojas, Enrique Lorenzo Espulgas, and Oscar Miranda, are among the many who have disappeared and about whom our Embassy in Buenos Aires has been unable to obtain any information. We will ask our Embassy to remain alert to any information that may become available concerning these individuals.

Accounting for the disappeared is one of the most difficult human rights problems facing the Argentine Government and one which we hope the Argentines will eventually resolve. At the same time, we will continue to use our influence directly and in international fora to encourage Argentine officials to make whatever information they may have available to the families of missing persons.
