## Native American Children May Be Eligible

Who are 3 or 4 years old on August 31, or turning 3 during the school year and leaving ESIT, ELICPSE, Early Head Start, or Early ECEAP and:

- Are from a family up to 100% state median income (about \$100,000 for a family of 4); or
- Qualify for school district special education services; or
- Have qualifying factors including:
  - Have a family member who attended an Indian Boarding School; or
  - Moved to engage in traditional cultural practices for subsistence or employment; or
  - Involvement in tribal or state child welfare services; or
  - Others factors
