The CBCAP Rescue Plan funding allows Washington to expand its community-based child abuse and neglect prevention activities, provide concrete goods and supports to families, and strengthen the network of statewide supports for families.

The MIECHV Rescue Plan funding provides for concrete supports to families receiving home visiting, technology and technical assistance to support service access and quality through the COVID pandemic, and enhanced training and retention supports to strengthen the workforce.
