AIM

1. The aim of this SOP is to outline the procedures and responsibilities for the provision of support to the JLSG HQ.

MISSION

- According to the DJSE concept, a JHQ Forward Support Element (FSE) has to provide support to DJSE elements in peacetime location and also in theatre. JHQ FSE is the DJSE element responsible for ensuring and coordination of RLS to DJSE elements during all phases of the mission. Under DJSE are included two staff elements: JHQ Forward Element (FE) and JLSG HQ.
 - a. To receive the support from JHQ FSE, JLSG HQ has to be collocated with JHQ FE. In that case, all HQ support is covered by JHQ FSE SOPs (600 serial).
 - b. In case of the JLSG HQ and JHQ FE are not collocated, a tailored JLSG HQ Support Element, dedicated to JLSG HQ, has to be set in order to guarantee the JLSG HQ RLS. In some cases, the role of a JLSG HQ Support Element can be supported by the Support Element of a JLSG unit as, for example, a Theatre Logistic Base (TLB).
 - c. The support provided to the JLSG HQ falls under three principle categories1:
 - (1) Real Life Support (RLS).
 - (2) Communications and Information Systems (CIS),
 - (3) Force Protection (FP).

ORGANISATION

- 3. The common organisation of a HQ Support Element is described in SOPs 600 Serial. The principles are as follow:
 - a. HQ Support Commander/Camp Commander
 - b. HQ Support Personnel/Administration & MWA
 - (1) Personnel and Administration
 - (2) Moral and Welfare activities (MWA)
 - (3) BUDFIN
 - (4) Medical Support
 - (5) Sanitation
 - c. HQ Support Life Support Operations & Force Protection
 - (1) Force Protection Measures
 - (2) CBRN Defense
 - (3) Internal Security
 - (4) Damage Control (DAMCON)

- (5) Counter Terrorism
- (6) Post-Attack Reconnaissance (PAR) and assessment
- (7) Explosive Ordnance Reconnaissance and Disposal (EOR/EOD)
- (8) Fire Fighting
- (9) Decontamination
- d. HQ Support Logistics (Supply, Services & Transport)
 - (1) Supply and Services
 - (2) Transportation
 - (3) Accommodation
 - (4) Food Service
- e. HQ Support Engineering Branch
 - (1) Engineering
 - (2) Environmental Protection
- f. HQ Support Communications and Information Systems
 - (1) Functional Area Services
 - (2) Non-Classified Services (Telephone and Internet)
 - (3) Three (in total) scanner/copiers
