1. Purpose. To publish the revised Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 holiday observations liberty periods for Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune (MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ) General and Special Staff Departments and MCIEAST subordinate commands.

2. Background. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Departments and MCIEAST subordinate commands will make every attempt to be in synchronization with the major tenant commands we support in alignment with references (a) and (b) and in accordance with the liberty limitations identified in references (c) and (d).

b. Modifications. MCIEAST Commanders are authorized to modify this routine for operational commitments, but are not authorized to exceed the specific duration. MCIEAST Commanders shall notify this headquarters of any modifications.

c. Risk Mitigation. All hands are reminded that the judicious and effective use of annual leave is a good risk mitigation tool for those desiring to travel outside established liberty boundaries who desire to extend their stay over specific holidays.

d. Liberal Leave. A liberal leave policy will be in effect for civilian personnel during these periods. Supervisors are encouraged to approve leave requests for civilian personnel in other than essential positions.


e. Expectations. Professionalism by MCIEAST personnel is the expectation. MCIEAST-MCB CAMLEJ Department Heads and MCIEAST Commanders are reminded about personnel excellence, risk mitigation, the value to command, safety, COVID-19 restrictions and anti-terrorism/force protection precautions before travel and recreation begins. Upon completion of all holiday periods, all subordinate commands shall report to the Chief of Staff accountability of MCIEAST personnel.
