

Court Pack

These are the 3 documents you will need to take with you to any Court:

1. Evidence that you are not the "NAME" (all capitals version which is **not** common English, proper noun. The ALL CAPITALS NAME is a Corporate letter form identifier, dog latin.
2. Evidence that AUSTRALIA is not on the land mass we are living on. But AUSTRALIA is in fact registered as/on Norfolk Island in the Pacific Ocean. The evidence to prove is the document attached: 2b of Acts Interpretation Act and SEC form 18KA.
3. Law Maxims which will address common 'objections' and support your details

Page 1 – form of information (obtain from Births Deaths Marriages) – ask for an adjournment to obtain this document if you don't already have it

Page 2 – Section 2b of Acts Interpretation Act of 1901 (Commonwealth) – see attached

Page 3 – (for in Court only) – relevant Law Maxims to quote

Your questions and what you say to the Court or Judge as follows:

1. my name is: insert ONLY your Christian name/s here – do not admit to the Surname at all
2. and may I ask the Judge who are you?
3. And may I ask what are you doing here?
4. I require facts to know where does your jurisdiction come from?
5. Are you acting extra territorially? (outside of Norfolk Island where AUSTRALIA exists)
6. Is Australia on Norfolk Island?

Always you want FACTS IN EVIDENCE, so "my honour, I require some facts in evidence please"






Your "new" Date of BIRTH is as shown on this form.


i.e. – your BORN date is the date your physically came from your mother

ACTS INTERPRETATION ACT 1901 - SECT 2B

Definitions

In any Act:

"*acting SES employee*" has the same meaning as in the [Public Service Act 1999](#).

"*Administrative Arrangements Order*" :

- (a) means an instrument (a *primary AAO*) made by the Governor-General that is described as an Administrative Arrangements Order; and
- (b) includes an instrument made by the Governor-General that:
 - (i) amends a primary AAO; or
 - (ii) revokes a primary AAO and substitutes a new primary AAO.

Note: The Administrative Arrangements Order sets out, from time to time, the matters dealt with by Departments of State of the Commonwealth together with the legislation administered by the Ministers for those Departments.

"*affidavit*" includes affirmation, declaration and promise.

"*appoint*" : see [section 33AA](#).

"*APS employee*" has the same meaning as in the [Public Service Act 1999](#).

ACTS INTERPRETATION ACT 1901 - SECT 15B

Application of Acts in coastal sea

Coastal sea of Australia

- (1) An Act is taken to have effect in, and in relation to, the coastal sea of Australia as if that coastal sea were part of Australia.
- (2) A reference in an Act to Australia, or to the Commonwealth, is taken to include a reference to the coastal sea of Australia.

Coastal sea of external Territory

- (3) An Act that is in force in an external Territory is taken to have effect in, and in relation to, the coastal sea of the Territory as if that coastal sea were part of the Territory.
- (3A) A reference in an Act to all or any of the external Territories (whether or not one or more particular Territories are referred to) is taken to include a reference to the coastal sea of any Territory to which the reference relates.

Definition

- (4) In this section, *coastal sea* :
 - (a) in relation to Australia, means:
 - (i) the territorial sea of Australia; and
 - (ii) the sea on the landward side of the territorial sea of Australia and not within the limits of a State or internal Territory;
and includes the airspace over, and the sea-bed and subsoil beneath, any such sea; and
 - (b) in relation to an external Territory, means:
 - (i) the territorial sea adjacent to the Territory; and
 - (ii) the sea on the landward side of the territorial sea adjacent to the Territory and not within the limits of the Territory;
and includes the airspace over, and the sea-bed and subsoil beneath, any such sea.

ID requirements

- You **MUST** provide proof of identity. You must provide three forms of identification, one of each from categories 1, 2 and 3. If you are unable to provide identification from category 1, you must still provide at least three forms of identification. At least two of these must be from category 3.
- All identification must be current (not expired). Utility bills or rate notices must have been issued within the last three months.
- An accredited translator, i.e. National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters (NAATI), must translate identity documents issued by overseas authorities into English.
- If applying in person at Service NSW, you must bring the original documents.
- If applying by post, you must enclose photocopies of each identity document. Do not send original documents with your application.
