We are dealing with a pandemic. Cases are rising. We must be clear with the public but we are now living with this disease. The numbers of hospitalizations & deaths is likely to keep rising for some time. In a few days' time we will be taking a decision on whether to move ahead with stage 4, but at the moment the data is encouraging, though and yet we are in a different situation for previous waves.
