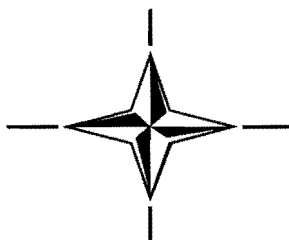

AIM

1. The aim of this agreement is to establish between the NATO Forces an equivalent sizing system of combat clothing, to facilitate interchangeability between them.

AGREEMENT

2. The NATO Forces concerned agree to apply as far as possible the guiding details listed below governing the interchangeability of combat clothing sizes.

GENERAL

3. This agreement is primarily limited to combat clothing used under temperate conditions, but the principles could be applied to combat clothing designed for other climatic conditions, and to specialized combat clothing such as Armored Fighting Vehicle (AFV) crew clothing.

4. It is not necessary to achieve full standardization of sizes in order to achieve interchangeability, although standardization should be the ultimate aim.

STATEMENT OF DETAILS

5. The details governing interchangeability of sizes are:

- a. Because of national differences in combat clothing design and the relationship between body measurements and garment measurements, body measurements will be used as a basis of comparison and interchangeability. Garment measurements, peculiarities of design and concept of fit can be taken into account when interpreting basic comparisons between the sizes of two or more countries.
- b. Measurements will be expressed in metric units and may also be expressed in English units,
- c. In order to effect interchangeability, each country must use the same body control measurements. These will be in the form of bivariate and will be height and chest for jacket sizing and inside leg and waist for trouser sizing. This does not preclude any country from using additional body control measurements for national purposes if it is so desired.
- d. Gradients will be used to form height groups and girth groups in the size scales. Ideally each country will use a 5 cm gradient or multiple thereof for each dimension, using the 0, 5, 10, 20 progression, but a degree of interchangeability can be achieved without this, for example, the US system of using 2—inch multiples for sizing US field clothing is almost equivalent to the 5 cm gradient.
- e. Overlapping of size gradients will be avoided if at all possible, as will gaps between gradients.
- f. Eight figure NATO code symbols will be used to denote given sizes in order to facilitate interchange. Countries may retain a national size symbol in addition to the NATO symbol. This may be expressed in adjectival form.
- g. The NATO symbol will be used on all garment labels and size scales.
- h. Countries will use as few sizes as possible compatible with the national concept of fit and logistic effort required to maintain the sizes in the supply system.

- j. Future work on sizing in all countries should aim towards further standardization of gradients and ultimately actual sizes.

UTILIZATION

- 6. National Size Conversion Graphs for the purpose of understanding each national sizing system are at ANNEX B for those participating countries.
- 7. Any amendments to national size scales and systems should be passed to the project custodian in order that new graphs can be prepared.

DESIGNATION OF SIZES

- 8. In order to designate a NATO size, an eight-figure symbol is used, the first four figure denoting the vertical measurement and the last four figures representing the girth measurement.

Example (Jackets):

Height gradient	170 to 180 cm
Chest gradient	95 to 105 cm
NATO size would be	7080/9505

Example (Trousers):

Inside leg gradient	75 to 80 cm
Waist gradient	80 to 90 cm
NATO size would be	7580/8090

INTERCHANGEABILITY

- 9. Equivalent Size Tables have been prepared on each of the participating national size systems for jackets, trousers, and field coat (see ANNEXES C, D, & E). These tables show the body control measurements in gradients for each national size of garment.
- 10. The graphs of any two countries may be overlaid so that the verniers are matched. The equivalent size or sizes of one country can then be read off against the size of any other. Because countries have not standardized on actual sizes or on the 5 cm multiple in the gradients, only in rare instances will one size be equivalent to one size of another country. Despite this, it is possible to make an overall comparison for logistics purposes.

11. It is essential that when a country makes an amendment to a size scale, new graphs are prepared showing the body control measurements, and these graphs replace those currently in use with this document. The project custodian must receive details of such amendments as they occur.

CONCEPT OF FIT AND DESIGN DETAILS

12. ANNEX A contains details on national concepts of fit, shown as differences between body measurements and garment measurements. It also gives details of garments worn underneath the combat clothing that would affect the sizing and also data on any special design features that should be taken into account. These include means of suppressing the girth of a garment, factors affecting length of trousers, etc.

13. When making comparisons of sizes full cognizance should be given to the data contained in ANNEX A, particularly if combat clothing is to be obtained from another country, as all factors discussed have an effect on interchangeability.

14. Again it is essential that, when a country makes changes that affect these factors, ANNEX A be suitably amended.

ADDITIONAL PARTICIPATION

15. It is possible for non-participating countries to be included in this program in the future. It will be necessary for such countries to provide data for inclusion in all Appendices.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

16. This STANAG will be considered to have been implemented when the necessary orders/instructions to adopt the method described in this agreement have been issued to the forces concerned.

NOTES ON ITEMS 1-6 OF ANNEX A TO STANAG 2335

1. CZE: There is a possibility of girth adjustment only for the jungle and desert combat jackets, not for the basic combat jackets. However, the jungle and desert jackets do not have a waist drawstring, they have textile tightening bands and buttons; possible girth adjustment: 7 cm and 14 cm.
GBR: The amount of suppression is not limited.
2. CZE: The difference in chest measurement; body/garment relationship in the chest is 20 cm for all sizes. Waist measurements are not decisive (soldier can use a belt).
FRA: As chest measurement is the control girth measurement for jackets, waist differentials are not available. Body/garment relationship in the chest ranges from 16 cm (sizes 108 and 120) to 20 cm (size 92), FR states that, by applying 12 cm to these figures which is the chest/waist relationship, an approximation of the waist differential can be arrived at.
3. CAN: Not on original Mk 1 combat clothing.
DEU: Non—elasticized waistband in channel with button—holed tabs at the ends.
4. CZE: Difference in waist measurement is 1 cm for the smallest size 78 and 3 cm for the other sizes.
5. DEU: For mountain troops.
FRA: The bottom of the FR trouser has an interior cuff which is placed inside the top of the ankle boot. The bottom (outer) part of the trouser is placed on top and tied with a drawstring. Two buckles are then tightened.
6. CAN: There is a storm cuff on the CA trousers. The inner portion tucks into the boot and the outer portion fastens outside the boot with a drawstring. The trouser legs can also be worn loose to provide ventilation.
CHE: Trousers are worn with a separate elastic cord around the top of the boot. Seam is then tucked in from beneath.
DNK: The bottom of the DK trousers may be tightened using a drawstring. FRA: The bottom of the FR trouser has an interior cuff which is placed inside the top of the ankle boot. The bottom (outer) part of the trouser is placed on top and tied with a drawstring. Two buckles are then tightened.
SWE: The trouser leg is equipped with a band with a snap fastener, which is closed around the bootlace in order to keep the trouser leg down.
7. USA: Trousers inseams are 75 cm and 82.5 cm. Distance from ground varies with inside leg measurement of individual.

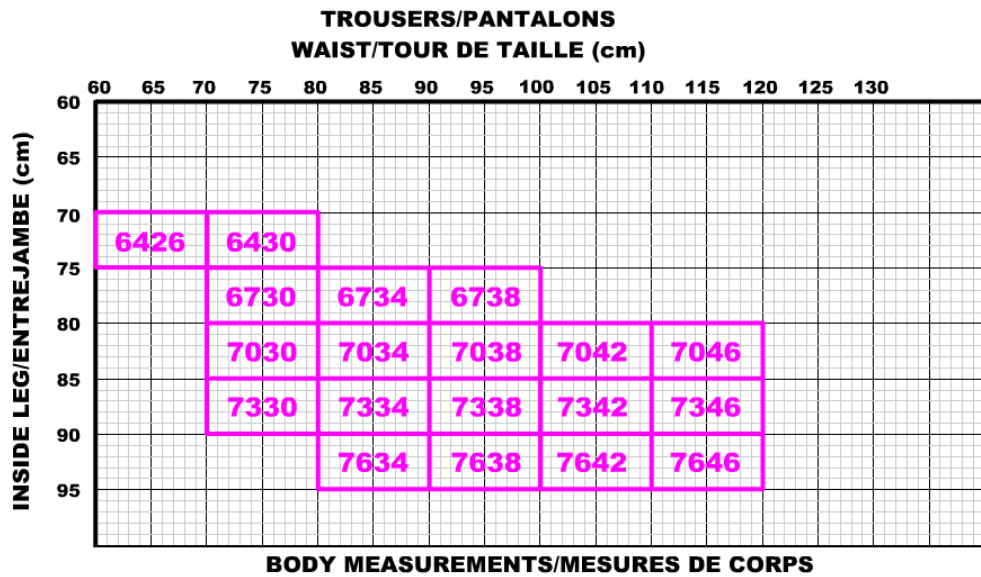
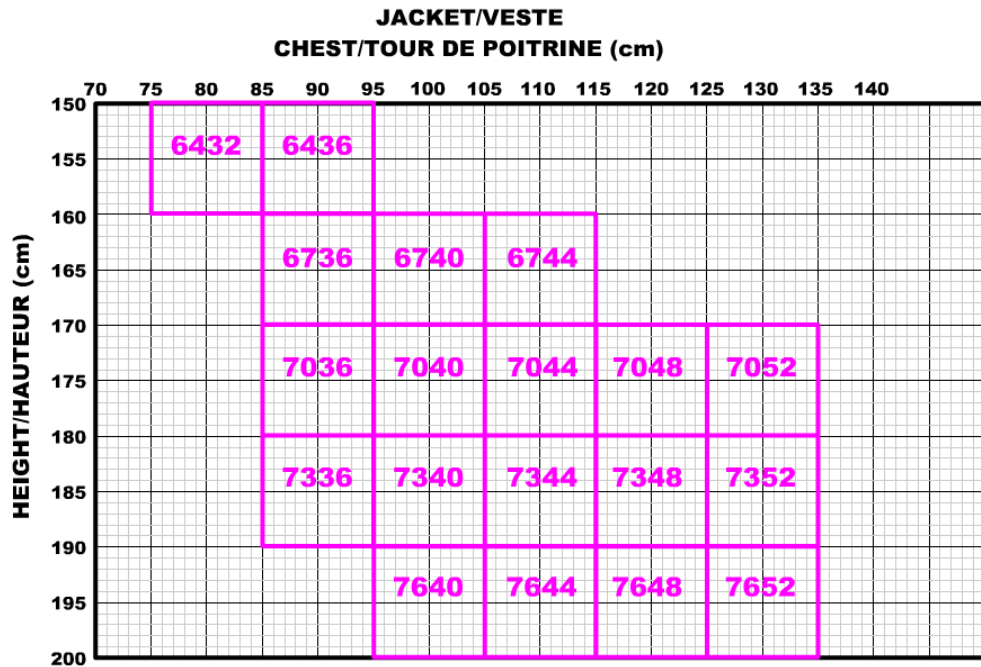

NATIONAL SIZE CONVERSION GRAPHS

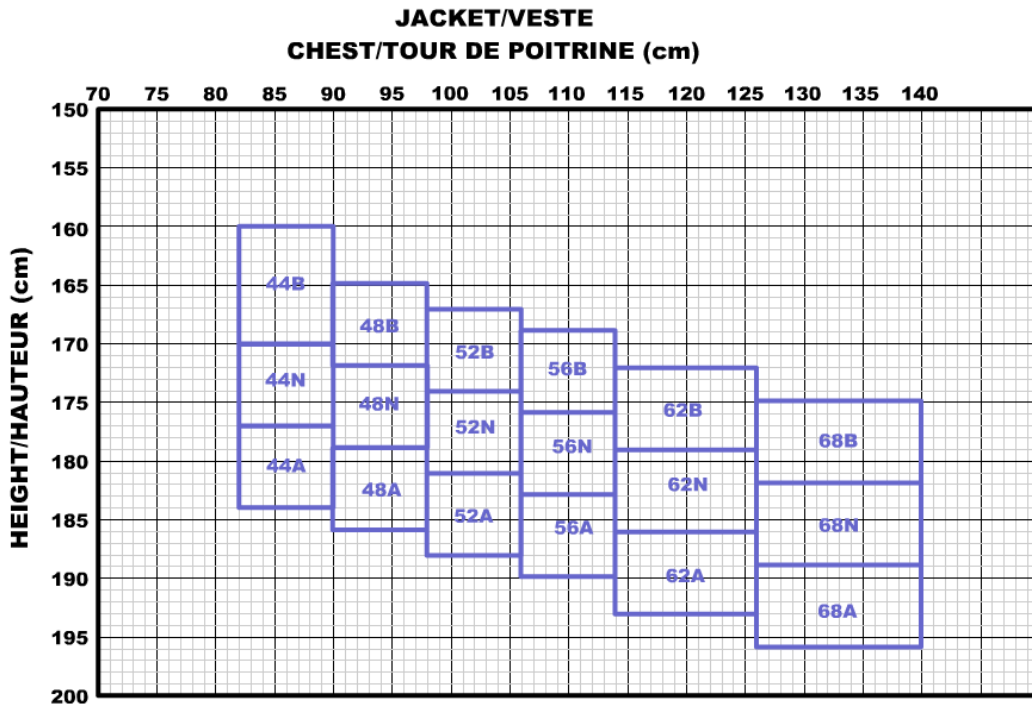
The graphs that follow can be printed on transparent films. When placed one on top of another, it will be possible to compare size gradients between nations.
