

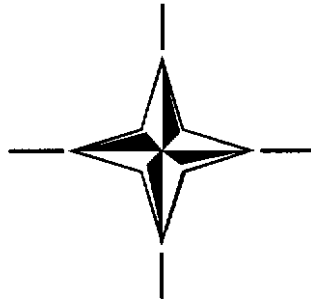

EXPLANATORY NOTES

AGREEMENT

1. This STANAG is promulgated by the Director NATO Standardization Agency under the authority vested in him by the NATO Standardization Organisation Charter.
2. No departure may be made from the agreement without informing the tasking authority in the form of a reservation. Nations may propose changes at any time to the tasking authority where they will be processed in the same manner as the original agreement.
3. Ratifying nations have agreed that national orders, manuals and instructions implementing this STANAG will include a reference to the STANAG number for purposes of identification.

AIM

1. The aim of this agreement is to register national acceptance of AJP-3.3.2(A).

AGREEMENT

2. Participating nations agree to use AJP-3.3.2(A).
3. Changes to AJP-3.3.2(A) will be incorporated into the publication and will be accepted as part of it provided they have been formally offered by the Joint Board, NSA to national authorities and have been agreed by them.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

4. This STANAG and AJP-3.3.2(A) are implemented when they have been received by the authorities and units concerned.
