

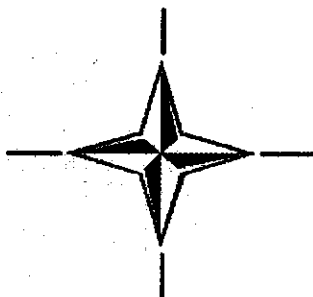



TRIAL REPORTS AND DESIGN CRITERIA FOR IN-SHELTER  
FUELLING AND DAMAGE REPAIR - AFLP-3

AIM

1. The aim of this agreement is to register national acceptance of AFLP-3 and all changes thereto.

AGREEMENT

2. Participating nations agree to use AFLP-3, as a reference manual when designing or updating protected aircraft shelters (PAS) and developing procedures for the repair of war damaged on-base fuel pipelines. The aim is to foster exchange of information and reduce duplication of effort within the Alliance and so bring about greater standardization in the field of in-shelter fuelling and pipeline repair.

3. Participating nations agree to forward any corrections or additions to AFLP-3 to the Custodian as required. As AFLP-3 is a compendium of trial reports any changes or additions will be incorporated in the publication without being offered to nations for agreement.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

4. This STANAG and AFLP-3 are implemented when the AP has been received by the authorities and units concerned.
