AIM

AGREEMENT

- 2. Participating nations agree to use AEP-52 as a manual for the assessment of effect levels of classical warfare agents applied to the skin to be used in the design of protective equipment.
- 3. Changes to AEP-52 will be incorporated into the publication and will be accepted as part of it provided they have been formally offered by the AC/225(JCBCBRN) to national authorities concerned and have been agreed by them.
