#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

#### <u>AGREEMENT</u>

1. This NATO Standardization Agreement (STANAG) is promulgated by the Chairman MAS under the authority vested in him by the NATO Military Committee.

2. No departure may be made from the agreement without consultation with the tasking authority. Nations may propose changes at any time to the tasking authority where they will be processed in the same manner as the original agreement.

3. Ratifying nations have agreed that national orders, manuals and instructions implementing this STANAG will include a reference to the STANAG number for purposes of identification.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

4. <u>Ratification</u> is "In NATO Standardization, the fulfilment by which a member nation formally accepts, with or without reservation, the content of a Standardization Agreement" (AAP-6).

5. <u>Implementation</u> is "In NATO Standardization, the fulfilment by a member nation of its obligations as specified in a Standardization Agreement" (AAP-6).

6. <u>Reservation</u> is "In NATO Standardization, the stated qualification by a member nation that describes the part of a Standardization Agreement that it will not implement or will implement only with limitations" (AAP-6).

#### RATIFICATION, IMPLEMENTATION AND RESERVATIONS

7. Page iii gives the details of ratification and implementation of this agreement. If no details are shown it signifies that the nation has not yet notified the tasking authority of its intentions. Page iv (and subsequent) gives details of reservations and proprietary rights that have been stated.

AIM

1. The aim of this agreement is to register national acceptance of ADatP-2.

#### AGREEMENT

- 2. Participating nations agree:
  - a. to recognize the International Data Processing Vocabulary ISO/IEC 2382, issued by the International Standardization Organization (ISO) and the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC), with all its forthcoming amendments, as a NATO standard;
  - b. to incorporate this international ADP vocabulary into the ADP NATO glossary, ADatP-2;
  - c. to use ADatP-2 and any subsequent amendments published periodically as the reference glossary for terms and definitions in the ADP domain.

#### **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT**

3. This STANAG and ADatP-2 are implemented when the AP has been received by the authorities and units concerned.
