INTRODUCTION

SCOPE

1. This publication details the NATO codes of military personnel ranks for use by nations when preparing personnel tables, requisitions, reports and returns destined for NATO nations, organizations and commands.
2. Nothing in this publication is to prejudice existing national grades designations or procedures in purely national establishments.
3. The NATO codes assigned for each grade shall be based on the agreed corresponding Army grades. National equivalent for Naval, Air Forces or other shall be in accordance with national regulations. These equivalences are contained in SRDs to this publication.

GENERAL

4. Officer and other rank posts will be identified by a NATO code within the following grades:

a.	Officers	OF-1 – 10
		General officer OF-6 to 10
		Senior officer OF-3 to 5
		Junior officer OF-1 to 2
b.	Other ranks	OR-1 - 9

5. For NATO purposes, OR-5 to OR-9 inclusive are considered Non-Commissioned Officers.

APPLICATION

6. The code is to be used in preparing:
 - a. Establishment tables.
 - b. Personnel statistics.
 - c. Strength returns.
 - d. Personnel requisitions.
 - e. Other reports dealing with personnel, to include Automated Data Handling (ADH) reporting procedures.
7. Personnel requisitions to fill NATO posts shall indicate the NATO code herein specified in conjunction with the approved manning document. Nations will normally be expected to fill allocated posts by personnel holding the grade indicated by the NATO code reflected in the manning document. Personnel holding a rank different from that stated in the manning document are expected to perform the duties of their post irrespective of their national rank.
8. Precedence when performing duties within NATO organizational and functional elements (Staff, divisions, branches, sections, unit, etc.) shall be in accordance with the approved manning document for that element.

9. When a manning document includes personnel of different nations and/or different services, the grade is to be preceded by the national distinguishing letters and one of the following abbreviations for the service concerned: (A) for Army, (M) for Marines, (N) for Navy, (AF) for Air Force, (CG) for Coast Guard and (SI) for Service Immaterial.

Example: Belgian Army Colonel = BEL (A) OF-5

OFFICER PERSONNEL - ARMY

NOTES

- BEL (1) In the Medical Service, the grades of medical, pharmacist, dental and veterinarian officers are the same as those of the Army. However, the rank is preceded by the specification:
- Médecin/Geneesheer.
 - Pharmacien/Apotheker.
 - Dentiste/Tandarts.
 - Vétérinaire/Dierenarts.
- (2) The Capitaine-Commandant is subordinate to a Major.
- (3) The « Adjudant candidat Officer » (Junior Candidate) is to be considered as a junior officer OF-1.
- BGR (4) The Army of the Republic of Bulgaria is referred to as "SUHOPATNI VOISKI" of the Bulgarian Armed Forces. In the Bulgarian Armed Forces both Army and Air Force use the same grades.
- CZE (5) In Czech Armed Forces the both services (Army and Air Force) use the same ranks.
- DEU (6) Equivalent ranks exist for medical personnel (Doctors):
- OF-8 "Generaloberstabsarzt".
 - OF-7 "Generalstabsarzt".
- (7) Equivalent rank exists for medical personnel (Doctors, Pharmacists):
- OF-6 "Generalarzt, Generalapotheker".
- (8) Equivalent ranks exist for medical personnel (Doctors, Dentists, Pharmacists, and Veterinaries):
- OF-5 "Oberstarzt, Oberstapotheker, Oberstveterinär".
 - OF-4 "Oberfeldarzt, Oberfeldapotheker, Oberfeldveterinär".
 - OF-3 "Oberstabsarzt Oberstabsapotheker, Oberstabsveterinär".
 - OF-2 "Stabsarzt, Stabsapotheker, Stabsveterinär".
- ESP (9) ESP retains the capability to post officers below the grade established in a manning document to fill allocated posts, in accordance with paragraphs 7 and 8 of this STANAG.
- FRA (10) This is not a rank but a title, which corresponds moreover to a high position in the State ("Dignité dans l'Etat").
- (11) « Général d'armée » and « Général de corps d'armée » are rank marks.

(12) In accordance with the general status of the French forces, the rank of « général de division » is the highest rank in the hierarchy. A « général de division » may, therefore, carry the 4 stars and 5 stars rank marks.

- (13) - In the Infantry, Engineers and Signals: "Chef de bataillon".
- In the Armoured Cavalry Corps: "Chef d'escadrons".
- In the Artillery and Train (Transport): "Chef d'escadron".

However, an officer of this rank is spoken to as "Mon Commandant" in all branches of the Army.

GBR (14) QARANC Queen Alexandra's Royal Army Nursing Corps

(15) In the performance of their duties in wards, nursing personnel are to use professional titles, e.g. nurse, sister, (charge nurse in respect of male nurses), senior sister, matron, etc.

(16) Rank applicable in wartime only.

(17) Royal Marines ranks are synchronised with those of the other United Kingdom armed forces. There is no OF-10 in the Royal Marines.

LVA (21) Equivalent ranks exists for Army and Airforce, differs for Navy. In National Armed Forces, Military Specialists (MSs) ranks are equal with Army ranks. Military Specialists (MSs) are military personnel responsible for legal affairs, medical, IT tasks, military band, psychologists and chaplain service. Duties performed by MSs are limited to those that do not require full general military education.

(22) In the Latvian Armed Forces the officer rank Lieutenant is identified by the Code OF-0.

MNE (23) In the Armed Forces of Montenegro both Army and Air Force use the same ranks for officer personnel.

NLD (24) Called "RITMEESTER" in the Armoured Cavalry.

(25) Vaandrig ("Kornet" in the Armoured Cavalry, Artillery and Royal Netherlands Marechaussee) is an officer candidate, who fulfills OF-1 posts and is entitled to the same prerogatives as officers.

PRT (26) A General who holds, or has held, the appointment of Chief of General Staff for the Armed Forces or Chief of the General Staff for the Army.

Exceptionally, they can also be assigned certain posts in the Ministry of Defence that are considered military duties in accordance with the law. Formational duties and duties performed by MSs are limited to those that do not require military education.
