On 4/7/66, a representative of the Naval Investigative Service, Washington, D.C., furnished to IC JOHN B. ARMSTRONG the following info about a VICTOR AGUAYO DELGADO, who may or may not be identical with the subject:

VICTOR AGUAYO DELGADO as of 9/24/41, was a Mexican alien born 3/3/07, in Guanjuato, Mexico, and resided at 4941. E. 111 St., Garfield Heights, Ohio. He was employed by the Willard Storage Battery Co., Cleveland, Ohio, which in 1941 received permission to employ DELGADO under provisions of a Navy or Aeronautical contract.

On 4/13/66, a representative of the Office of Special Investigations, Department of the Air Force, Washington, D.C., advised IC MICHAEL V. DEVOL that from a review of the records of the Office of Special Investigations, he could locate no info identifiable with the subject.

On 4/14/66, a representative of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), Office of Central Reference, Biographic Register, Washington, D.C., advised SA PAUL F. DOUGHERTY that from a review of the records of the Biographic Register, he could locate no info identifiable with the subject.

On 4/18/66, a representative of the Central Office, Immigration and Naturalization Service, Washington, D.C., advised IC HUGH L. KNIGHT that from a review of the records of the Central Office, he could locate no info identifiable with the subject.

On 4/28/66, WF 1683 Spadvised SA DONALD HOETING that he knows a VICTOR M. DELGADO who was born in Havana, Cuba, is about thirty-six years old and was an attorney and notory in Havana, Cuba, prior to his entry into the U.S. in 1960 or 1961. WF 1683 Stadvised that he doubted that VICTOR M. DELGADO was involved in any activities for or against the regime of FIDEL CASTRO in Cuba, but was of the opinion that DELGADO was anti-CASTRO due to the fact that he, DELGADO, lost many of his possessions in Cuba due to the advention that CASTRO regime.
